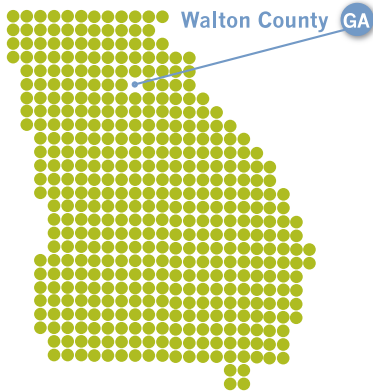

## Pace Learning Systems helped Walton County Public Schools increase their graduation rate by more than 25 percent!

When Dr. Tim Lull became superintendent of Walton County Schools in 2004, the district, part of a seven-county school group, ranked at the bottom of the list on high school exit exam pass rates. In fact, in the 2002-2003 school year, their high school graduation rate was 58%.

In the 2005-2006 school year, the graduation rate increased to 73.5% — a 26.7% increase! This graduation rate exceeds both state and national averages.

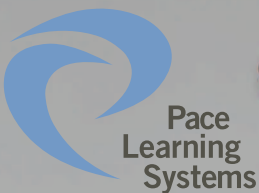
Dr. Lull attributes this achievement to the hard work of students and teachers at Walton County Public Schools and also praises the contribution made by Pace Learning Systems.

Dr. Lull first used Pace Learning Systems materials in 1994 as a remediation tool at Decatur High School with students who failed the Alabama High School Exit Exam. About half of the failed students volunteered to be in a remediation program using the Pace Learning program.
